

Board of Trustees Special Meeting Monday, August 18, 2008 5:00 p.m.

MINUTES

President Burtch called the meeting to order at 5:08 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Perera made a motion for the Board to go into Executive Session in order to confer with an attorney concerning disputes involving the public body that are the subject of pending or imminent court action. The Board members did note that the Library is very pleased that the Court's decision clarifies that it may accommodate the First Amendments rights of all groups by granting them equal access to its meeting room space without violating the Establishment Clause.

There was brief discussion of an additional payment to Joel Snyder Associates in the amount of \$6,500.00 for the presence of Joel Snyder and Bill Wilson at the meeting.
